**Your background:**

- Your expertise is based on a university degree in human medicine, nutritional science or ecotrophology, or related sciences, ideally focusing on nutritional medicine, as well as a doctorate completed with outstanding success (at least “magna cum laude”).
- You are able to deliver courses in both German (comparable to level C1) and English.
- You already have at least two years' experience working in a higher education institution, e.g. as an academic staff member.

- The assistant professorship provides you with an important foundation for a successful career in academia.
- We offer you salaried employment as a lecturer with specific duties for a fixed term of three years, with remuneration over and above the standard salary up to pay scale E 14 (TV-L), dependent on your personal qualifications and professional experience.

- In a well-equipped environment, you will have the opportunity to conduct research and develop yourself professionally.

- By delivering courses in English, you will support the university's internationalisation strategy.
